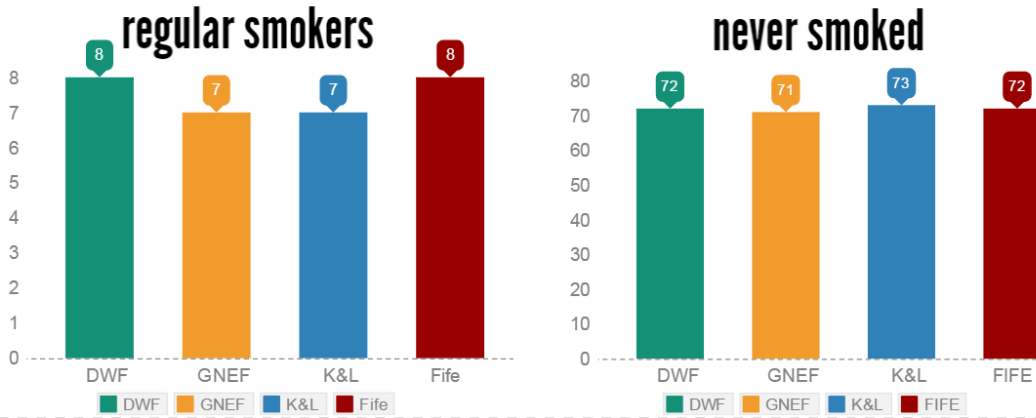

% of 13 and 15 year olds



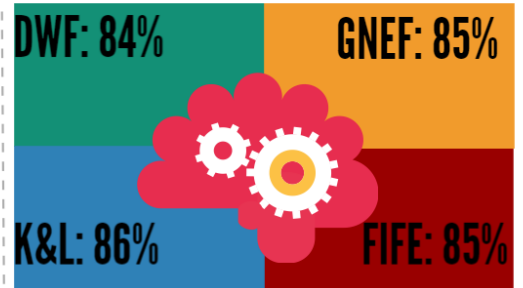
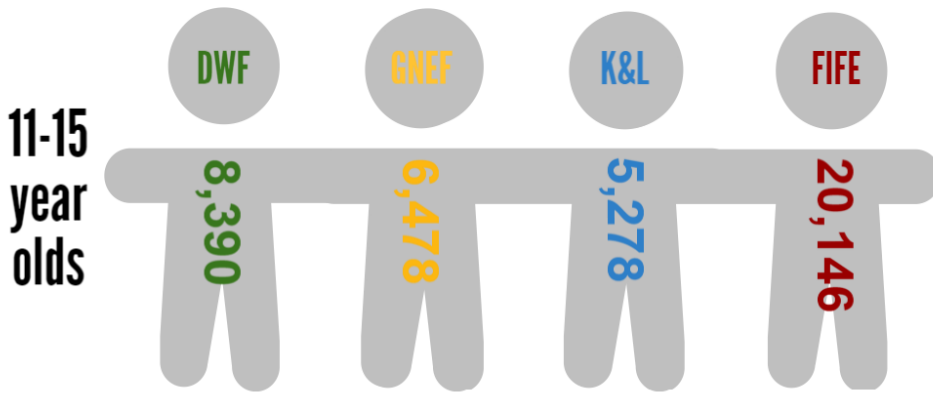

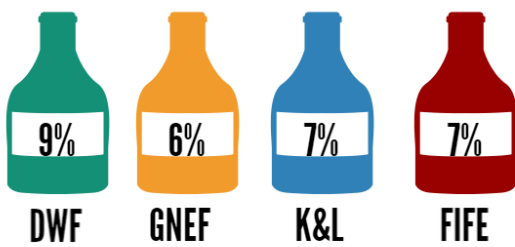

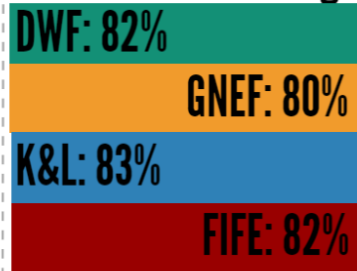


% of 13 & 15 year olds with above average or average positive mental wellbeing

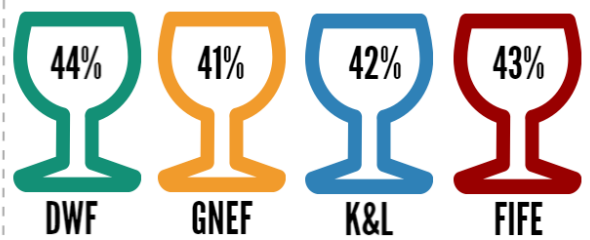
% of 13 & 15 year olds who drank alcohol at least once a week



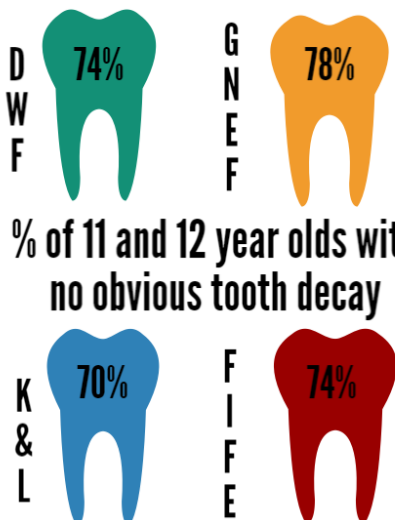
% of 15 year olds who have never used drugs

% of 11 and 12 year olds with no obvious tooth decay

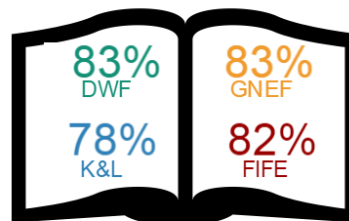

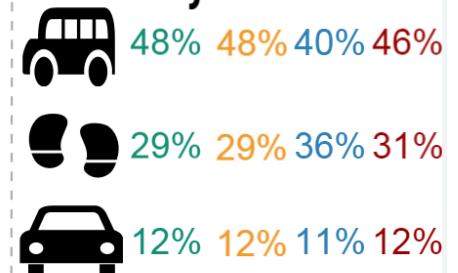
