

Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD) 2016

The Scottish Government published the latest SIMD on 31 August 2016. SIMD16 is a relative index, ranking areas across Scotland from 1 (most deprived) to 6976 (least deprived).

The [KnowFife Dataset](#) can be used to explore absolute change within an area or neighbourhood. Selected indicators from the SIMD can be viewed at a variety of geographic areas through:

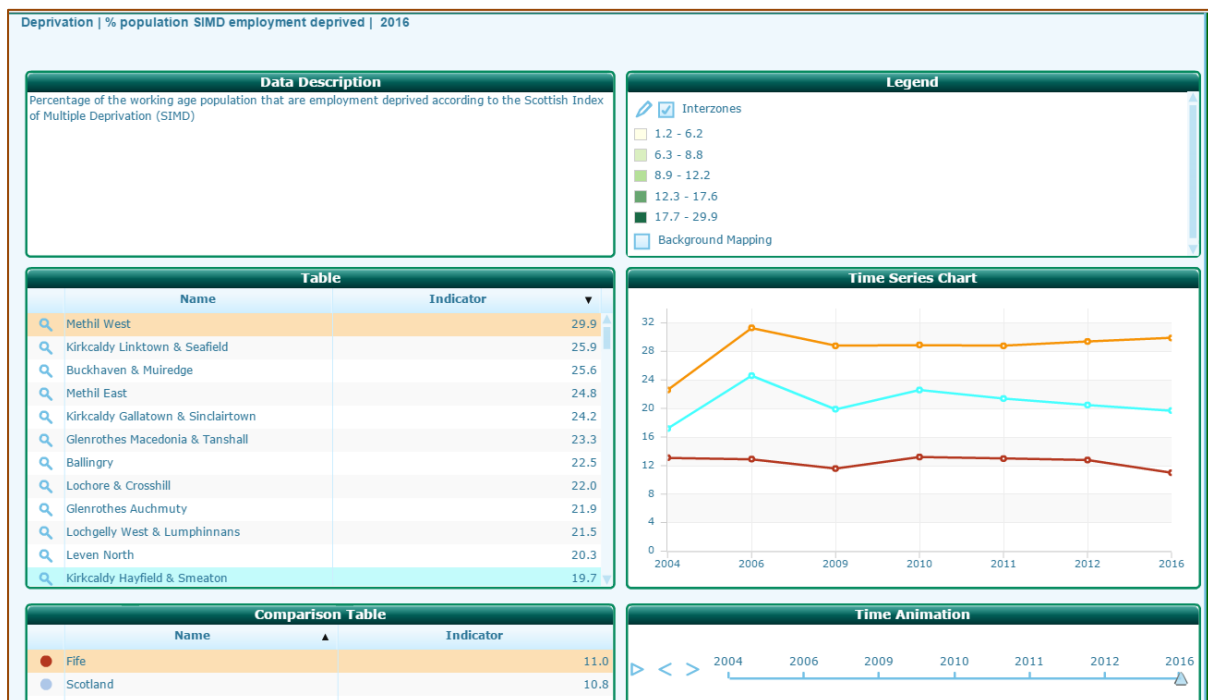


Figure 3 – Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation Interactive Map by Interzone showing change over time in employment deprivation in selected neighbourhoods (KnowFife Dataset)
